School readiness is not just about a child's age or being able to count or recite the alphabet.

For a smooth transition to 'Kindergarten' and to become happy, confident and successful learners they need to have a strong grasp of the following skill sets

Social Emotional & Independence Skills

 Separate from parents, make eye contact, Manage frustration and avoid tantrums, ask for and accept help, Wait patiently, do up lunchboxes, bags, clothes and more.



 Recognise their first name, draw simple shapes, Hold correct pencil grip and classify objects, retell a story, Attempt to solve problems independently and more.

Communication Skills

 engages in conversation, questions and story telling, jokes, rhymes and songs and will assert self with words and more,

Gross Motor Skills

- Move around confidently in many environments e.g. stairs, uneven ground
- Kick, Catch and throw a ball with a partner
- Play coperatively for at least 30 minutes
